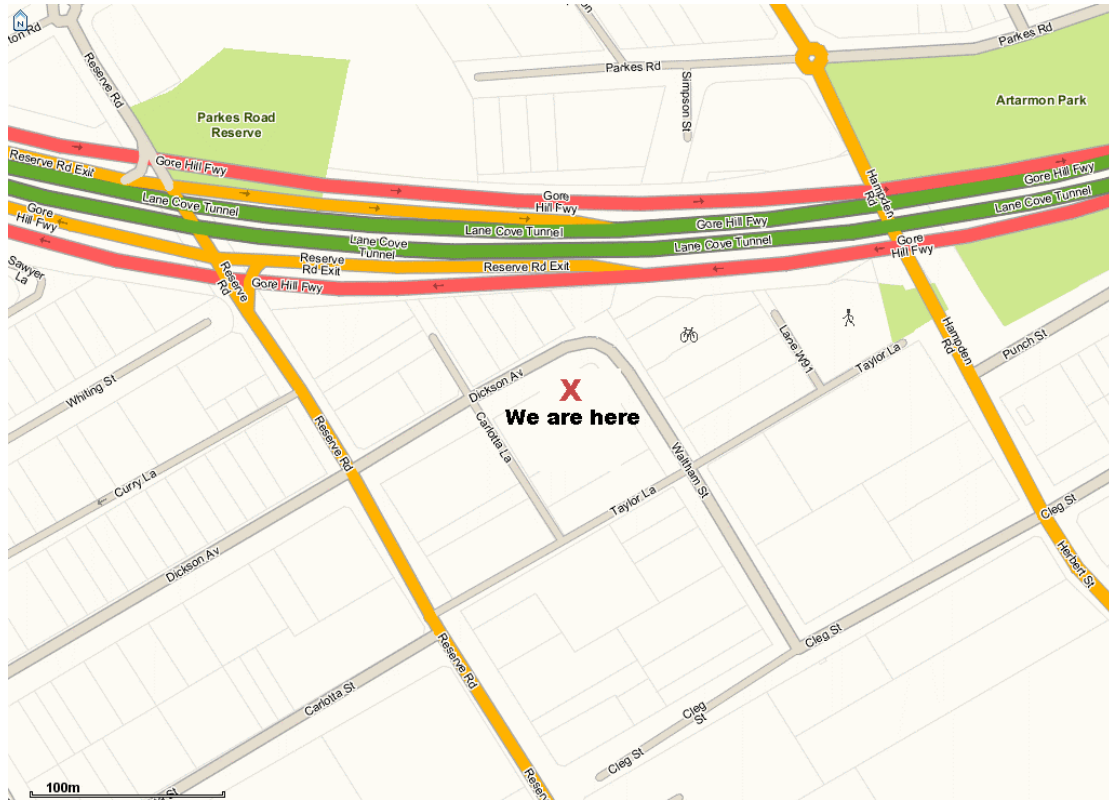

**On Site Facilities:**

We have all the usual amenities for your use during the course of the day. Feel free to use our tea and coffee making facilities, copious cold water, fridge for your lunch and a microwave. There is an onsite coffee shop that is open for trade at 0830. There are numerous cafe's within 5 minutes walk or bring your own lunch.

Whilst on site we can supply all your rope access kit for training or bring your own kit along and providing we are satisfied, feel free to use it.

You will need to bring a pen and notebook and appropriate clothing. We suggest shorts, t shirt, comfortable footwear and a jumper during the winter months.

Whilst you are here you can browse our small store area to buy that new piece of kit, get some new dynamic lanyards or just get some advice from our knowledgeable and friendly staff.

**The Courses:**

AIRA can offer various options for your course requirements, to keep it simple, we offer Irata levels 1,2 & 3 as both a traditional 4 day course followed by 1 day assessment. We also offer Irata levels 1,2 & 3 as a part time night course. Carried out on Tuesday and Thursday nights, four hours a night, over a four week period followed by a one day assessment.

You will gain practical and theoretical knowledge from experienced operators, a reference manual that has been put together by our in house instructors (usually costs \$110), audio visual aids, a purpose designed training centre, Irata publications as required and access to a wealth of knowledge.

Our normal 4 day course and assessment costs **\$ 1540** including GST.

Our night course and assessment costs **\$ 1 760** including GST.

The full price must be paid by close of business on the first day of training. For ease we prefer EFT transfers. Credit Card facilities are available on site.

# IRATA TRAINING SCHEME FLOWCHART

See IRATA *General requirements* for the detailed syllabus, requirements for levels 1, 2 and 3 rope access technicians, and principal contra-indications to working at a height and other relevant information.



\*Any level 2 or 3 rope access technician undertaking re-assessment after the expiry of the current assessment would require four days of training instead of the two days. Holders of expired level 2 or 3 certificates or others with questions should contact an IRATA training company for information on revalidation procedure. To ensure technicians are up to date with certification, re-assessment may be done up to 6 months before due expiry date without any time penalty.

Each IRATA member company should ensure employees hold valid assessments.
